

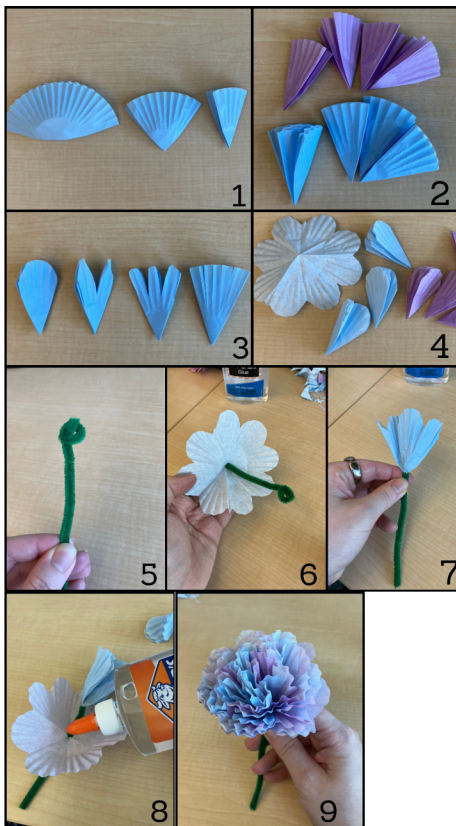
CUPCAKE WRAPPER FLOWERS

Materials

- 8 cupcake wrappers
- Green pipe cleaner (approximately 6")
- Glue

Directions

1. Begin by flattening the cupcake wrapper so it creates a semicircle, then fold it twice to create a pie piece shape.
2. Repeat for all 8 cupcake wrappers.
3. Use scissors to shape the rounded end, similar to cutting paper snowflakes. Different cuts will create different designs. Repeat for all 8 wrappers.
4. Unfold all of the wrappers and lay them flat.
5. Make a small knot at one end of your pipe cleaner.
6. Poke a hole through the middle of the wrapper (inside of wrapper toward the knot) where all of the fold lines meet. You will be adding the wrappers starting with the center of the flower and adding new layers to the outside.
7. Pinch the bottom of the wrapper on the bottom, where the pipe cleaner is inserted to create a cone.
8. Continue adding wrappers by poking the pipe cleaner through them, but before you push it all the way to the top, add a circle of glue around the hole to help it stick to the previous layer.
9. Once you have added all wrappers, fluff up the layers to make it look more like a flower.



CUPCAKE WRAPPER FLOWERS
